

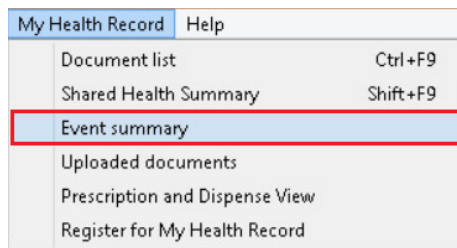


Uploading an Event Summary

Note:

These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient's Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system, and the patient has a My Health Record. If your software has not been connected, or the patient's IHI has not been validated, visit the Australian Digital Health Agency website (www.digitalhealth.gov.au) for information on readying your organisation for the My Health Record system.

- Once you have opened the patient's local medical record and entered the clinical information and notes for the consultation, select the **My Health Record** drop-down menu, then select **Event Summary**.



- Select **Import Current Visit Notes** (top-right corner) to populate the Synopsis box with the consultation notes from the patient's local medical record.

The Synopsis can also be entered/edited manually.

Tick/untick the items to include/not include in the Event Summary, then select **Upload** (bottom-right corner).

Please review the data displayed below before sending the Event Summary to My Health Record.

An event summary is used to capture key health information about a clinically significant healthcare event that could be relevant to the ongoing care of an individual. It is not a complete health summary and should not be wholly relied upon, nor should it replace direct communication between healthcare providers.

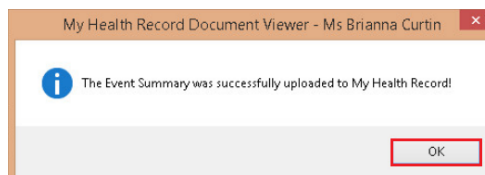
