



# Stop a prescribing record being sent to My Health Record

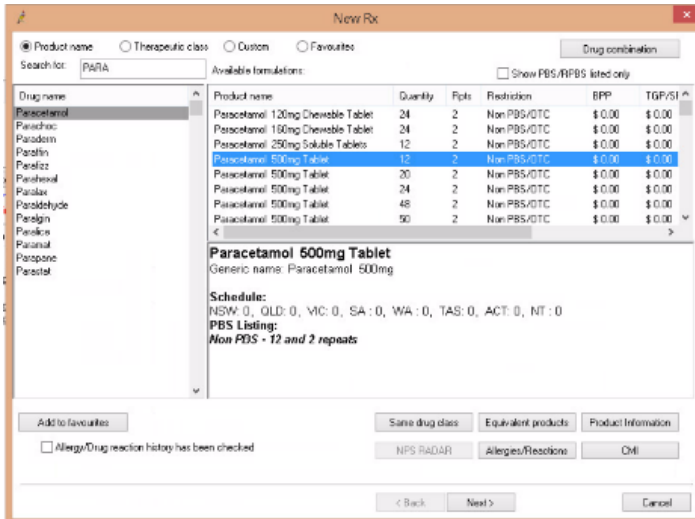
## Note:

For My Health Record registered organisations using electronic prescribing, prescribing documents will default to the **Send to My Health Record** option. To stop a prescribing document from being uploaded:

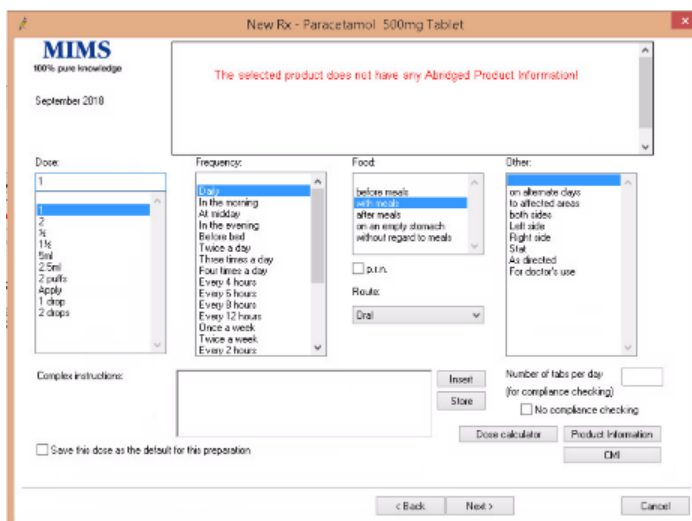
1. Select **New Rx** from the top menu (top-left corner)
