



Request for diagnostic imaging report not to be sent to My Health Record

Note:

Your patient may wish for certain diagnostic imaging reports not to be submitted to My Health Record. We encourage you to discuss this with your patient. This will not affect your current business process of requesting and receiving diagnostic imaging reports, it simply stops the information being sent to your patient's My Health Record.

1. In the **Referral Selection**, select a **New Referral > Radiology**, and then tick the box next to **'Do not send reports to My Health Record'**.
